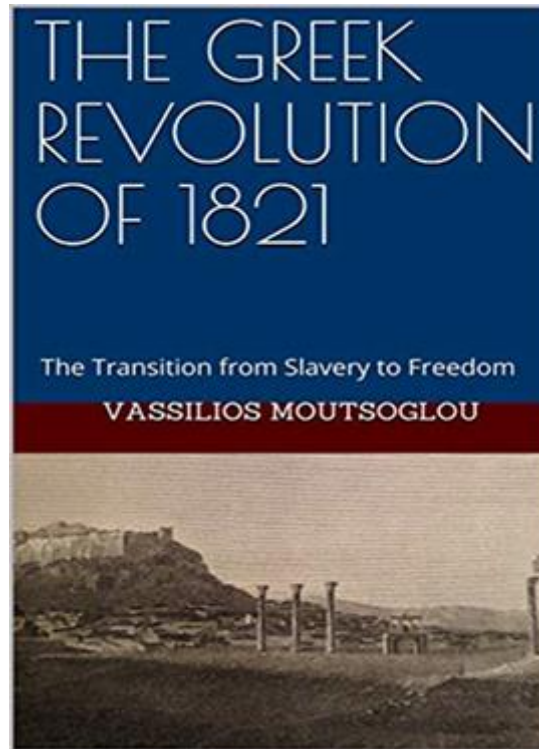


The Greek revolution of 1821
