

## **POLITICAL ACTUALITIES**

The civil war that followed produced untold human suffering and sparked a massive exodus of Syrians to Lebanon, Jordan, Turkey and to Europe further afield, including Greece.

We in Greece have historic and indelible ties with the Syrian space and also with the modern state of Syria, on the basis of non-interference in its domestic affairs. We are concerned with the fate of the large Christian communities in Syria and Lebanon, the Orthodox in particular, organized under the aegis of the ancient Patriarchate of Antioch, based nowadays in Damascus. In the current circumstances, we recognize that the Syrian Arab Army is the foremost guarantor of safety and survival of all minority communities in Syria, along with the Syrian Democratic Forces of the Syrian Kurds and allies. In this time of necessity for moral and political clarity we assess positively support of both our strategic partner Egypt and security partner Saudi Arabia for President Assad s government.
